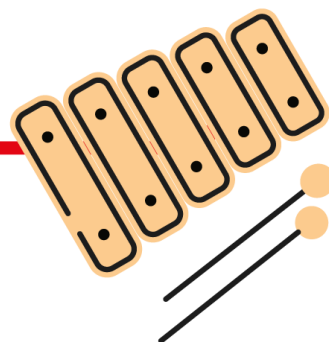

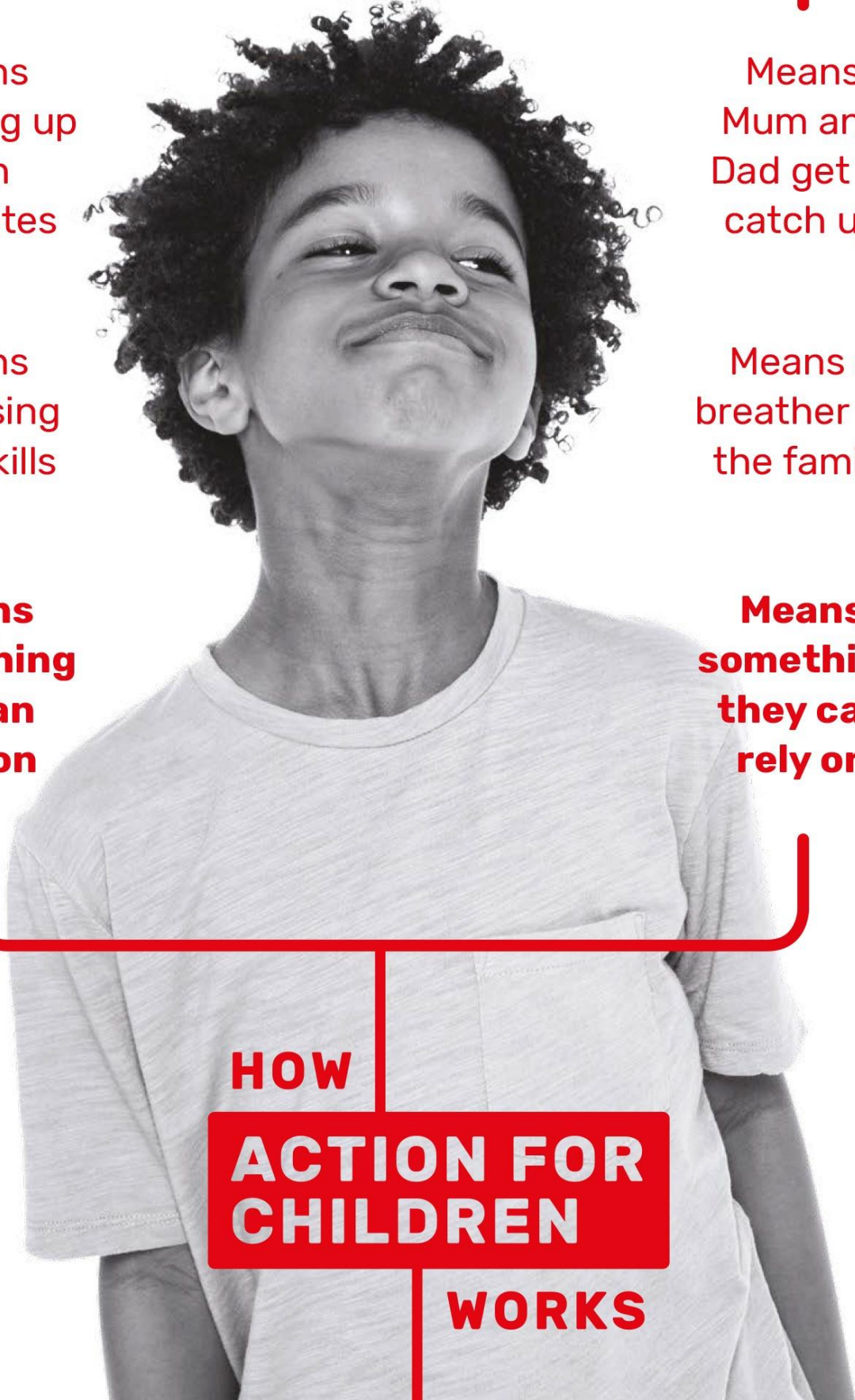

## **\*\*Important Message\*\***
